



## Mountaineer Mondays Handicapping Tournament Official Rules

1. Walk-up registration only on each Monday in August 2017 (Aug. 7, 14, 21, 28). Registration table is located in the upper level clubhouse racing area.
2. Must be 18 years of age or older on the day of the tournament and have a valid ID to register and participate in the Tournament.
3. The entry fee is FREE!
4. Maximum one (1) entry per person. No partnerships.
5. A minimum of twenty-five (25) contestants must be registered prior to the first contest race or the tournament will be cancelled.
6. Prize structure: 1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$100; 2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$50; 3<sup>rd</sup> Place - \$75
7. Contestants will select the winning horse, and an alternate horse, in each race at Mountaineer, and have a mythical \$2.00 WIN wager on each selection.
8. All selections must be made and entered into the contest before the first race.
9. The contestant with the highest number of winning selections at the conclusion of all of the tournament races will be declared the winner.
10. In the event that a contestant's horse is scratched from a race, the alternate horse will replace the scratched horse in that race. If both selections are scratched the race will have no selection.
11. In the event of a dead heat, both horses will be considered the winner.
12. In the event that two (2) or more contestants have the same number of winning selections, the tiebreaker will go to the contestant with the highest total combined payoff price for each of the correctly selected winners of the tournament races.
13. In the event that two (2) or more winners have the same number of winning selections, and the highest total combined payoff price, the contestant with the largest single-race payoff will be declared the winner.
14. In the event that two (2) or more winners have the same number of winning selections, and the highest total combined payoff price, and the largest single-race payoff, the contestants will split the prize pool.
15. Illegible or incomplete entry forms will be disqualified.
16. No changes may be made to an entry after it has been submitted.
17. Winners must be present to claim their prize at the conclusion of the last tournament race. If the winner is not present, the second place contestant will be declared the winner and receive the prize.
18. Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes, and will be required to complete Form W-9.
19. Prizes are non-transferable.
20. Participants shall sign a release and agree to have their name or image appear in any publicity material (posters, newsletters, programs, etc.).
21. Employees of Youngstown Real Estate Ventures, LLC, Sportech, Inc., and immediate family members are not eligible.
