APPETIZERS

GIANT PRETZEL

whole grain mustard and cheese sauce

SPINACH ARTICHOKE DIP

parmesan and mozzarella cheese served with pita wedges

HOLLYWOOD NACHOS

tortilla chips, shaved lettuce, sliced jalapeños, salsa, sour cream

WINGS: TRADITIONAL OR BONELESS

buffalo / sriracha bourbon / garlic parmesan / sweet bbq / dry cajun / dry parmesan ranch

RACE DAY PLATTER

house chips, crackers, ham, pepperoni, cheddar, provolone cheese, mustard dip and pickled peppers

SOUPS: CUP OR BOWL

wedding soup / soup of the day

SALADS

HOUSE SALAD

mixed greens, tomato, cucumber, onion, mozzarella

CAESAR SALAD

chopped romaine, parmesan cheese, house made croutons, classic caesar dressing

VALLEY SALAD

seasonal greens, strawberries, pickled beets, goat cheese, strawberry poppyseed dressing

ADD: chicken / 7oz steak / shrimp / salmon

HOMESTYLE

HOUSE MADE MEATLOAF

classic beef and pork recipe served with brown gravy, mashed potatoes, house vegetable, roll, and side salad

SPAGHETTI AND MEATBALLS

house made marinara, meatballs, and roll

SANDWICHES

MYCHOICE BURGER

build your own burger - ask waiter for ordering pad

REUBEN

shaved pastrami, swiss cheese, sauerkraut, marble rye, and thousand island dressing

DOUBLE DECKER CLUB

turkey, ham, bacon, tomato, lettuce, swiss cheese, mayonnaise

PHILLY CHEESE STEAK

shaved beef, onions, mushrooms, peppers and provolone cheese

CHICKEN SALAD

diced chicken breast tossed with sundried cranberries, and toasted pecans in a special house sauce served on a toasted croissant

ENTRÉE

CHICKEN ALFREDO

creamy house made alfredo topped with parmesan cheese

12OZ RIBEYE

topped with onion rings and steak sauce served with salad and two sides

BBQ SPICE RUB SALMON

with white wine butter sauce, served with salad and two sides

DESSERTS

CARROT CAKE

topped with vanilla sauce and whipped cream

CHOCOLATE CAKE

topped with dark chocolate and white chocolate sauce and whipped cream

CHEESECAKE

topped with strawberry sauce and whipped cream

WAGERING BASICS

TYPES OF WAGERS: EXOTIC

Exotic wagers allow you to bet on multiple horses in a single bet, allowing you to increase your profit potential.

EXACTA: You're betting on two horses to come in first and second in an exact order. For example, if you place a \$2 exacta on horses 2 and 5, you can only collect if horse #2 comes in first and horse #5 comes in second.

TRIFECTA: You're betting on three horses to come in first, second and third in an exact order. For example, if you placed a \$2 trifecta bet on 1-3-7, you can only collect if horse #1 comes in first, horse #3 comes in second and horse #7 comes in third. The minimum bet on a Trifecta is often 50 cents, which makes it more affordable.

SUPERFACTA: You're betting on four horses to come in first, second, third and fourth in an exact order. For example, if you placed a \$2 superfecta bet on 2-4-6-7, you can only collect if horse #2 comes in first, horse #4 comes in second, horse #6 comes in third and horse #7 comes in fourth. The minimum bet on a Superfecta is often 10 cents, which makes it more affordable.

DAILY DOUBLE: You're betting on the WIN horse for two consecutive races.

PICK THREE: You're betting on the WIN horse for three consecutive races.

PICK FOUR: You're betting on the WIN horse for four consecutive races.

Check the top of the program page for wagers offered in each race.

BOX: You can "BOX" an exacta, trifecta or superfecta bet, which means your horses can come in any order and you still win. Boxing an exacta costs twice as much as a straight exacta bet. A \$2 exacta box on horses 3 and 5 will cost you \$4. You collect if horse #3 comes in first, and horse #5 comes in second, or if horse #5 comes in first, and horse #3 comes in second. Since boxing a wager can get expensive, you can box most exotic wagers for \$1, and some as little as \$0.10.

WHEEL/KEY: This type of wager can be used when you feel that one of your selections will finish in a certain position, either first, second or third. The horse you select to finish in a certain position is your "KEY" horse. The other horses you have selected may then finish in any order and you are a winner.

The more horses you put in a box or wheel bet increases the number of betting combinations and increases the cost of your ticket.

WHERE AND HOW TO BET

SELF-SERVICE:

When visiting a Self-Service Terminal, follow these steps:

- 1 - Insert **CASH**, betting **VOUCHER**, or winning **TICKET**.
- 2 - Select **TRACK** and **RACE NUMBER**.
- 3 - Enter **BET AMOUNT**.
- 4 - Select **BET TYPE**.
- 5 - Select **RUNNERS**.
- 6 - Double check your bet. If incorrect, choose **START OVER**. If correct, select **PRINT TICKET** to purchase.
- 7 - Continue with another **BET** or **FINISH** transaction.

Remember to collect ticket and remaining cash balance before leaving the Self-Service Terminal

TYPES OF WAGERS: STRAIGHT

With a straight wager, you only bet on one horse.

WIN: You're betting that your horse will come in first place. If your horse finishes in first, you win.

PLACE: You're betting that your horse will come in first OR second. If your horse finishes in first or second, you win. Payout for a place bet is usually less than a win wager.

SHOW: You're betting that your horse will come in first, second OR third. You have a higher chance of winning, but the payout for a show bet is usually a lot less than a win or place wager.

A \$2 minimum is usually required to place a WIN, PLACE, or SHOW bet.

ACROSS THE BOARD: This allows you to wager WIN, PLACE and SHOW at the same time. It's three different bets on one ticket. For example, a \$2 across-the-board wager will cost you \$6, because you're making three \$2 bets. If your horse comes in first, you get the win, place and show money. If your horse finishes second, you get the place and show money. If your horse comes in third, you only get the show money.

HORSE-BETTING FACTS:

Favorites win 35% of the time. Favorites PLACE (run 1st or 2nd) 55% of the time. Favorites SHOW (run 1st, 2nd, or 3rd) 69% of the time. - Rich Nilsen, "How Well do Horse Racing Favorites Perform?", 2-14-12

The morning line is not who the racetrack odds-maker likes in the race. It's his prediction of how the public will bet the race based on the past performance of each horse.

HOLD ALL TICKETS:

HOLD ALL TICKETS until the race has been declared official and the "OFFICIAL" sign has been posted.

MINORS:

Minors accompanied by an adult are always welcome. However, anyone under the age of 18 years old are NOT permitted to either purchase or cash any mutuel ticket or be around any mutuel window at any time.

TELLER:

When visiting a teller window, follow these steps:

- 1 - State the **TRACK** you would like to wager on.
- 2 - State the **RACE** you wish to wager on.
- 3 - State the **DOLLAR AMOUNT** of your wager.
- 4 - Tell the clerk the **TYPE OF WAGER** you would like.
- 5 - State the **NUMBER OF THE HORSE** you wish to wager on.

EXAMPLE:

"Dayton Raceway, race one, \$2 to WIN on #7."

CHECK YOUR TICKETS BEFORE LEAVING THE TELLER WINDOW!
