

Pick a Horse Palooza - Official Rules

Promotional Period

- Hollywood Gaming at Mahoning Valley Race Course will conduct a "Pick a Horse Palooza" promotion on Saturday, May 4, 2024 from 2:00pm until approximately 7:00pm*.
- 2. A total of one hundred twenty (120) winners will be randomly selected and awarded PENN Bonus Play or cash.
- 3. Twenty (20) winners will be selected approximately every one (1) hour.
- 4. All times referred to throughout these rules are Eastern Standard Time (EST).

Eligibility

- 1. Must be an invited member of the PENN Play program.
- 2. Must be 21 years of age or older to obtain a PENN Play card.
- 3. No purchase is necessary to receive a PENN Play card.
- 4. A valid government issued photo ID may be required upon request to verify age and identity.
- 5. Eligible PENN Play members will be invited by mail and determined by historical level of play factors including but not limited to trip frequency, tier, VLT machine denominations played, average bet, length of play, and length of time since last visit.
- 6. The drawing drums will open at 1:00pm to accept entries mailed to invited guests.
- 7. All invited guests must bring in the entries they receive via mail and deposit tickets into the drawing containers of their choosing on the promotion date. The drawing drums will close at the time of each drawing time hourly from 2:00pm until 7:00pm or the end of the Derby. The drums will re-open after winners are selected. No additional entries may be submitted once the drum closes for the grand prize drawing hour.
- 8. Hollywood reserves the right to provide replacement tickets on a case-by-case basis to invited guests who are identified as unable to receive mail.
- 9. There will be ten (10) drawing drums that contain two (2) horses for each drum to correspond to the twenty (20) horses listed in the 2024 Kentucky Derby. Each invited guest will have ten (10) tickets to deposit in the drawing drums for the horse(s) they would like to have a chance to win. Guests have the choice to deposit their tickets in whichever drum they choose. In the event a ticket is accidentally placed into a drum by mistake, it cannot be removed and must remain. These tickets will be used for preliminary drawings and the finale drawing.
- 10. Drum one (1) will contain horse one (1) and horse eleven (11). Drum two (2) will contain horse two (2) and horse (12). Drum three (3) will contain horse three (3) and horse thirteen (13). Drum four (4) will contain horse four (4) and fourteen (14). Drum five (5) will contain horse five (5) and horse fifteen (15). Drum six (6) will contain horse six (6) and horse sixteen (16). Drum seven (7) will contain horse seven (7) and seventeen (17). Drum eight (8) will contain horse eight (8) and eighteen (18). Drum nine (9) will contain horse nine (9) and horse nineteen (19). Drum ten (10) will contain horse twenty (20).
- 11. Should there be fewer than twenty (20) horses in the Kentucky Derby, drums not assigned to a horse will be considered as a race day scratch and tickets may still be entered into the drum for a one hundred (\$100) PENN Bonus Play prize.
- 12. Invited guests can win unlimited preliminary drawings and one (1) grand finale prize.

Preliminary Drawings

- 1. On the indicated drawing day, preliminary drawings will be held approximately every one (1) hour from 2:00pm to 6:00pm.
- 2. During the preliminary drawing each hour, two (2) tickets will be drawn out of each drum for a total of twenty (20) tickets.

- 3. A total of twenty (20) winners will be called at each drawing time for one hundred (\$100) PENN Bonus Play.
- 4. Prize distribution is as follows:

- 5. During each scheduled drawing, the winning PENN Play account number along with the winner's first name and first initial of their last name will be announced on the gaming floor public address system. The same information will also be posted on large projection screens and other monitors throughout the gaming floor.
- 6. Winners must be present and have five (5) minutes to claim their prize at the promotion desks.
- 7. No additional redraws will be conducted for the 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, 5pm and 6pm preliminary drawings.
- 8. PENN Bonus Play will be credited to each winner's PENN Play account within one (1) hour of being awarded. Winners can simply insert their PENN Play card into any VLT machine and enter their PIN to download PENN Bonus Play prizes.
- 9. PENN Bonus Play credits will be valid for thirty (30) days and expire at 11:59 pm on the final valid date.
- 10. PENN Bonus Play prizes are not subject to any federal, state, and local taxes.

Grand Prize Drawing

- 1. *On the drawing day, the drums will close once the Kentucky Derby race starts. Following the Derby, the finale prizes will be awarded.
- 2. Winning tickets will be selected with two (2) tickets drawn out of each drawing drum and prizes awarded in accordance with the outcome of the Kentucky Derby.
- 3. A total of twenty (20) grand prize winners will be selected. The first through fifth place horses of the Kentucky Derby will be the first through fifth place drums in the finale drawing. The first place horse identified in the Kentucky Derby will be the first place drum in the drawing. Any horse that scratches will result in a two hundred fifty (\$250) PENN Bonus prize being awarded to the winner of the corresponding drums. Any horse and drum outside of the first through fifth place or horse that scratches will result in a one hundred (\$100) PENN Bonus Play prize during the finale drawing.
- 4. In the event the prize value of the two (2) horses on the drums do not match, the first drawn ticket will receive the higher prize value.
 - a. Example: Drum 1 contains the first place horse and horse eleven (11), a horse that scratches. The first drawn ticket will be for the first-place horse for a prize of two thousand five hundred (\$2,500) cash and the second ticket drawn will be for two hundred and fifty (\$250).
- 5. Prize Structure:

5 th Place Horse	\$500 PENN Bonus Play

- 6. During the scheduled drawing, the winning PENN Play account number along with the winner's first name and first initial of their last name will be announced on the gaming floor public address system. The same information will also be posted on large projection screens and other monitors throughout the gaming floor.
- 7. In the Grand Prize Drawing, winners of prizes five hundred (\$500) and greater must be present and have five (5) minutes to claim their prize at the promotions table located in the Food Court. In the event a winner is not present after five (5) minutes for their prizes, another winner will be selected. Redraw winners will have three (3) minutes to claim their prize. There will be a maximum of ten (10) redraws and then all unclaimed prizes will be forfeited.
- 8. Winners who place in sixth through twentieth will not have a redraw and any unclaimed prizes will be forfeited from the prize pool.
- 9. PENN Bonus Play will be credited to each winner's PENN Play account within one (1) hour of being awarded. Winners can simply insert their PENN Play card into any VLT machine and enter their PIN to download PENN Bonus Play prizes.
- 10. PENN Bonus Play credits will be valid for thirty (30) days and expire at 11:59 pm on the final valid date.
- 11. PENN Bonus Play prizes are not subject to any federal, state, and local taxes.
- 12.
